### Description of physical features / characteristics

- What does it look like?
- How does it move?
- Warm or cold blooded?

### Adaptations - Does it have an behaviors or physical features that help your animal

- find a mate?
- ward off predators?
- live in its environment?

- How many live in the wild?
- Are these animals in any zoos? How many live in zoos?
